Born in Vancouver, John Scott started on piano at the age of 9. Soon after, he started learning flute and saxophone. At the age of fifteen, John began playing bass guitar in rock projects and soon after picked up guitar as well.

By the time John was sixteen, he had performed in a minor Symphonic Orchestra and won many awards for flute. John was also performing saxophone in a few Jazz bands and then guitar and bass in numerous projects. At 17, the rock scene had captured his interest.
